

CDTA Pre-Employment Screening Program (PSP)



The Pre-Employment Screening Program (PSP) is a screening tool that allows motor carriers and individual drivers access to driving records from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's (FMCSA) Motor Carrier Management Information System (MCMIS).

- ✓ Save time and money by making a more informed decision when hiring drivers.
- ✓ Rapid electronic access to commercial driver safety performance information. Records are available 24 hours a day via Web request.
- ✓ Driver Information Resource (DIR) records contain the most recent 5 years of crash data and 3 years of roadside inspection data.
- ✓ Request records for up to 10 drivers at one time
- ✓ Search a driver's history in multiple states. One low fee regardless of the number of states queried for a driver.
- ✓ Withdraw from the program anytime

*** Motor carriers may request Driver Information Resource records solely for the purpose of conducting pre-employment screening and only with the operator-applicant's written consent. Individual drivers or owner operators may order their own Driver Information Resource record at any time.
